We just copied and pasted the information from the concentration CIM block to this page. \n\nThe only two changes that are being proposed include: (1) Adding NURS 5112 and (2) Clarifying that students are required to complete 3 hours Thesis or 3 hours independent study - for a total of 39 hours.   (1) NURS 5112 is the Clinical Practicum for Advanced Health Assessment and is taken with NURS 5101. It was previously left out by accident. This change corrects it.\n\n(2) Keeping thesis or independent study hours at 3 credits ensures that the total number of hours required for the program for all students will be at 39 credit hours.
