	Description and justification of the request		(1) The physics faculty recently voted to replace our course-based PhD candidacy exam with a research-based candidacy exam. The department believes this will help us recruit more students into our program, help us retain more students in our program, and allow our students to more quickly get involved in research. 2) The physics faculty recently voted to reduce the number of required courses. The department believes this will allow our students to more quickly get involved in research. (3) The physics faculty are also requesting to delete a concentration. The concentration does not exist in this software tool (Program Management). However, the registrar's office informed us that ADHE has this concentration on file. The concentration name is: PhD in Physics with a Concentration in Space and Planetary Sciences. The concentration has never had a student in the program. (4) Current and future students will be given the opportunity to have Astrophysics, Biophysics, or Neuroscience concentration printed on their transcript, which will help them meet specific job requirements. In addition, these concentrations should allow the physics department to attract more students interested in Astrophysics, Biophysics, and Neuroscience to our PhD program.
