Authority

- Teaching of graduate-level classes or dual-listed 4000 level classes
- Serve on or chair master's committees
- Serve on or chair Ed.S. committees
- Serve on or chair MFA committees
- Serve on doctoral committees
- Chair doctoral committees (for those with doctoral degree)

Minimum Qualifications

- Doctoral or MFA degree and evidence of proficiency

Classification Group II, Group II-T

Authority

- Teaching of graduate-level classes or dual-listed 4000 level classes
- Serve on or chair master's committees (may not chair MFA committees)
- Serve on Ed.S. committees
- Serve on MFA committees
- Serve on doctoral committees

Minimum Qualifications

- Doctoral or MFA degree and evidence of proficiency

Classification Group III, Group III-T

Authority

- Teaching of graduate-level classes or dual-listed 4000 level classes
- Serve on or chair master's committees (may not chair MFA committees)
- Serve on Ed.S. committees

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's or Ed.S. degree and evidence of proficiency

Classification Group IV, Group IV-T

Authority

- Teaching of graduate-level classes or dual-listed 4000 level classes
- Serve on master's committees (excluding MFA committees)

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree and evidence of proficiency

Classification Group V, Group V-T

Authority

- Teaching of graduate-level classes or dual-listed 4000 level classes

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree and evidence of proficiency

Classification Group VI, Group VI-T

Authority

- For graduate assistants only, teaching of graduate-level classes or dual-listed 4000 level classes

Minimum Qualifications

- Supervision of a faculty member
- Cannot teach peers
